### Tubing securement tab

The **Multi Fix Gentle** features a tubing securement tab which is designed to hold the catheter or medical tubing in place, without causing damage to the tubing. The catheter or medical tubing is held away from the skin, reducing discomfort form the tubing rubbing or resting on the skin.

Any movement of the catheter or medical tubing can result in discomfort or trauma, which is why it is recommended that urinary catheters and medical tubing are secured effectively.

The tubing securement tab is mounted on a re-adhesive silicone gel strip, which can be applied in a position to suit you. There is no skin preparation required prior to applying the **Multi Fix Gentle**, and it can be gently removed without the use of solutions or chemicals.


